

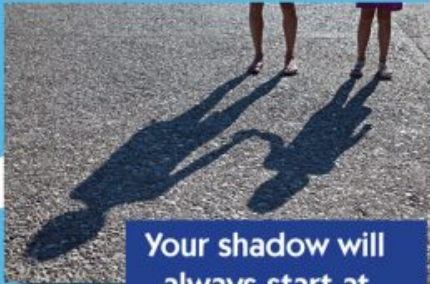
Did You Know? Shadows

DID YOU KNOW? SHADOWS



When the sun is directly above you, there is little or no shadow because the light from the sun is falling upon you.

Sundials use shadows to tell the time.



Your shadow will always start at your feet.

A transparent object does not make any shadow because light passes straight through it.

Your shadow is longest in the early morning and in the late afternoon because the sun is lowest in the sky and aimed at the sides of the various objects on the earth.

Any object – living or non-living that can block light can cast shadows.
